ARBITRATOR CONTINUING EDUCATION (ACE)

Annual Requirement

All commercial, construction and employment arbitrators must annually complete Arbitrator Continuing Education (ACE) to maintain their "active" status on the AAA's Roster of Arbitrators. To satisfy this requirement, it is necessary to complete one ACE eligible program annually (there is not an hourly requirement).

The ACE requirement should be satisfied as early as possible in each calendar year, but it must be completed by November 15th.

For calendar year 2020, qualifying courses satisfying the ACE requirement will be limited to the following:

ACE 20 - Cyber Security: A Shared Responsibility
